## 34th ANNUAL KYOCERA JAPANESE SCHOLARSHIP FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR OF 2017-2018

The Japanese Language Program in the Department of Linguistics and Asian/Middle Eastern Languages at San Diego State University is pleased to announce a generous contribution from Kyocera International, Inc., as a scholarship for an outstanding student of Japanese. This **Kyocera Japanese Scholarship**, with a stipend of \$1,500, will be awarded on the basis of competition with the following rules.

- 1. Study of Japanese at SDSU during the academic year of 2016-2017.
- 2. An applicant must be an officially matriculated student at SDSU at the time of application.
- 3. Minimum GPA: 2.75
- 4. Essay (handwritten) in Japanese:
  - Why do you think that you deserve this scholarship?
  - How has the study of Japanese enhanced your major?
  - How will the study of Japanese impact your career?

The essay should not be more than 1200 characters (not more than three sheets of *genkooyooshi* 原稿用紙)。

- ⇒ Essay in Japanese must be written at SDSU Test Office between Monday, April 3 and Saturday, April 8.

- 5. The recipient of the scholarship is **required** to study Japanese at SDSU (or at our exchange partner institution in Japan) during the year of the award: 2017-2018.
